**SUMMARY**

The top priority of the Sunnyside Fire Department is public safety and incident/hazard mitigation. In order to accomplish this, we must have mechanically operational apparatus. Our city mechanics do excellent work on preventative maintenance and most all other mechanical maintenance on our units. However, some fixes and maintenance require an EVT (Emergency Vehicle Technician), specifically for our pumpers and aerial. There is an extreme shortage of EVT certified mechanics and most agencies certified at that level are weeks if not months out on being able to provide maintenance or service.

This ILA would allow Sunnyside Fire to utilize the EVT-Certified mechanics with Yakima County Fire District #5 on an emergent basis (i.e. on an emergency scene, immediate need, etc.). The intention of this ILA is for situations that require EV Technicians without the ability to utilize our regularly contracted entities, NOT to replace the work conducted by our city mechanics or other available resources. The only costs associated with this agreement would be for services rendered. There is no cost associated with the agreement itself.

**RECOMMENDATION**

Approve a resolution authorizing the City Manager to enter into an interlocal agreement with Yakima County Fire District 5 for emergency equipment maintenance repair services.
