**SUMMARY**

The Department of Ecology and City of Sunnyside entered into an Agreed Order for conducting Remedial Investigation at the Sunnyside Municipal Airport for a pesticide operation which had been found contaminated for toxaphene, dieldrin, dichlorodiphenyltrichloroethane (DDT), and dichlorodiphenyldichloroethylene (DDE) at concentrations considered harmful to public health. Soil and groundwater sampling at the site was found to be above state cleanup levels. The final remedial investigation was submitted to Ecology in December 2014. In July 2015, Ecology amended the Agreed Order to include completing a Feasibility Study to describe the cleanup options, timeframes, and costs, and have also required a Cleanup Action Plan. The City of Sunnyside advertised and selected the Pacific Groundwater Group dba Mott MacDonald to prepare the above-mentioned Remedial Investigation, Feasibility Analysis, and Cleanup Action Plan. This item is to amend the contract with Mott MacDonald by \$149,260 to complete the work described above which is in addition to the original contract. The City has a grant with the Department of Ecology to cover the requested contract amendment on a reimbursement basis.

**RECOMMENDATION**

Make a motion to authorize the City Manager to execute the contract amendment with Mott MacDonald, LLC.
