WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside has previously entered into agreements to provide jail services to other jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside, has determined that it must be competitive in the market; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside has determined that adjustments to the daily bed rate to a minimum of \$ in existing Interlocal Jail Agreements is in the best interest of the city; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sunnyside has determined that it should also negotiate new Interlocal Jail Agreements for jail services at this new daily bed rate; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and determines that approval of such Agreement is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Sunnyside

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF SUNNYSIDE, WASHINGTON:**

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to negotiate, execute, and administer such amendments and agreements for jail services on behalf of the City of Sunnyside for a daily bed rate of a minimum of \$68.99. Excluding the US Marshals and Washington State DOC.

SECTION 2. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be effective upon passage,
approval and signatures heron in accordance with law.
